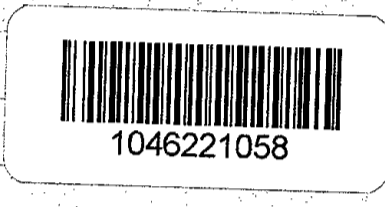

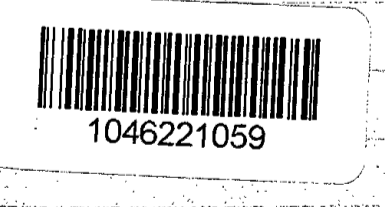

Griffith by Duncan Bell as appraised on the 27th of July 1893, against the late James Kettle, now due by Edmund Kettle in virtue of a certain deed of sale to him granted by Mrs James Kettle on the second of April 1907, registered under no. 22060. The appraiser hereby acknowledges to have received in deduction of the sum to him transferred the sum of eleven hundred and fifty dollars of principal and all interest accrued thereon up today, leaving a balance of \$1750.00. In consideration of this payment the said William H. Griffith hereby subrogates with all guarantees Mrs James Wraydale in all his rights, actions, privileges and benefits against said Edmund Kettle relating to the said sum of \$1750.00. To these presents also came and appeared the said Edmund Kettle, the debtor of the said sum of \$1750.00. Who has declared that he is satisfied with the subrogation above stipulated and considers it as having been to him duly signified, furthermore he binds himself to pay the said sum of \$1750.00 to Mrs James Wraydale according to the terms mentioned in said transfer of the 27th of July 1893, with interest thereon at the rate of four per cent per annum, instead of the rate of interest mentioned in said transfer to be computed from today and payable annually, Done and Passed, at Laclute town in the office of the notary on the nineteenth day of February one thousand nine hundred and ten, under the number ten thousand one hundred and seventy and the parties hereto have signed with and in the presence of said notary after due reading hereof signed W.
